W H A T I S A N F P C A ?

Federal Post Card Applications, better known as FPCA's, are application forms used for registered voters who are in the military or overseas during elections. While studying abroad, you can still make your voice be heard by voting absentee by mail-physical or email!

Important Dates

OCTOBER 15TH

Last day to send applications

NOVEMBER 5TH

ELECTION DAY

Last day to have ballots postmarked to be counted

Return ballots AS SOON AS POSSIBLE to Office of Elections to ensure that they are counted.

- Current mailing address while overseas
- Last date in the United States
